2008 – 2009 YESHIVA HOCKEY LEAGUE PROGRAMS AND DESCRIPTIONS

Learn To Play Hockey Level I:

Learn to play hockey is our starter hockey program offered at a discounted rate for new participants who have never participated in a Yeshiva Hockey program. It is open to boys ages 6 and above with some basic skating skills who wish to try hockey. Professional instructors teach the basics of skating and puck handling in a fun atmosphere using a variety of games, exciting drills, and races. Rental skates, helmet, and stick will be provided free of charge (refundable deposit required). No additional equipment is required. The program consists of 6 sessions beginning September 14th and ending October 26th. All sessions take place on Sunday between 3:15pm – 4:30pm at Sportorama ice rinks. Enrollment is limited.

Learn To Play Hockey Level II:

Level II is a progressive continuation from the basic skills taught in level I. Skating for hockey will continue to be the primary focus, along with an emphasis on skating with a puck, passing, shooting, defensive play, positioning, and, most importantly, game strategy. Sessions include mini games which put recently learned skills into immediate practice. Visiting coaches and skilled players contribute unique tips and specialties. *Full protective equipment is required for this program.* The program consists of 6 sessions beginning November 11th and ending December 14th. All sessions take place on Sunday between 3:00pm – 4:00pm at Sportorama ice rinks. A league jersey and socks will be provided and are included in the price.

League B (Grades 3 - 4):

The Yeshiva Hockey League B is an exciting hockey program consisting of both games and clinics. The program begins November 2nd and concludes February 22nd. It is open to boys in grades 3 and 4 who have since completed a previous Yeshiva Hockey program. While instruction and development are the focus of this program, games will be played with chosen teams. Teams will be formed through an initial assignment under the discretion of the directors and coaches. Teams may be modified during the season to prevent the domination of any given team. A team jersey and socks will be provided and are included in the price.

League A (Grades 5 – 7):

The Yeshiva Hockey League A is an exciting full hockey season. The program begins November 2nd and concludes February 22nd. It is open to boys in grades 5 through 7 who have since completed a previous Yeshiva Hockey program. In addition to regular games, the program includes team practices. These are sessions where teams will train together and work on the skills needed most by their team. A shorter game will take place following each team practice. The final week consists of a championship game for the two highest ranking teams. Teams will be formed through an initial assignment under the discretion of the directors and coaches. All attempts will be made to maintain a balanced and competitive league. The number of participants per team is limited to maximize active game time per player. Parents will be notified of team placement prior to the start of the first game. Teams may be modified during the season to prevent the domination of any given team. A team jersey and socks will be provided and are included in the price.

JERSEYS

Players in Leagues A and B will receive team specific jerseys and socks. The price is \$25 and is included in the overall cost of the program. Jerseys and socks will be distributed following formation of teams. This will take place on Sunday, November 16, 2008 any time between 3:00pm – 6:30pm.

Players in Learn to Play Hockey Level II will receive a league Jersey and socks as well. Distribution date is the start of the program, Sunday, November 11th, 2008 at 2:30pm.

Yeshiva Hockey Waiver of Liability, Release Assumption of Risk & Indemnity

It is the purpose of this agreement to exempt, waive and relieve releasees from liability for personal injury, property damage, and wrongful death, including if caused by negligence, including the negligence, if any, of releasees. "Releasees" include Yeshiva Hockey, its affiliate associations, local associations, member teams, event hosts, Sport-o-Rama ice rink, other participants, directors, coaches, officials, sponsors, advertisers, and each of them, their officers, directors, agents and employees.

For and in consideration of the undersigned participant's registration with Yeshiva Hockey, its affiliates, local associations and member teams being allowed to participate in Yeshiva Hockey events and member team activities, participant (and the parent(s) or legal guardian(s) of participant, if applicable) waive, release and relinquish any and all claims for liability and cause(s) of action, including for personal injury, property damage or wrongful death occurring to participant, arising out of participation in Yeshiva Hockey events, member team activities, the sport of ice hockey, and/or activities incidental thereto, whenever or however they occur and for such period said activities may continue, and by this agreement any such claims, rights, and causes of action that participant (and participant's parent(s) or legal guardian(s), if applicable) may have are hereby waived, released and relinquished, and participant (and parent(s)/ guardian(s), if applicable) does(do) so on behalf of my/our and participant's heirs, executors, administrators and assigns.

Participant (and participant's parent(s)/guardian(s), if applicable) acknowledge, understand and assume all risks relating to ice hockey and any member team activities, and understand that ice hockey and member team activities involve risks to participant's person including bodily injury, partial or total disability, paralysis and death, and damages which may arise there from and that I/we have full knowledge of said risks. These risks and dangers may be caused by the negligence of the participant or the negligence of others, including the "releasees" identified below. These risks and dangers include, but are not limited to, those arising from participating with bigger, faster and stronger participants, and these risks and dangers will increase if participant participates in ice hockey and member team activities in an age group above that which participant would normally participate in. I/We further acknowledge that there may be risks and dangers not known to us or not reasonably foreseeable at this time. Participant (and participant's parent(s)/guardian(s), if applicable) acknowledge, understand and agree that all of the risks and dangers described throughout this agreement, including those caused by the negligence of participant and/or others, are included within the waiver, release and relinquishment described in the preceding paragraph.

Participant (and participant's parent(s)/guardian(s), if applicable) acknowledge, understand and assume the risks, if any, arising from the conditions and use of ice hockey rinks and related premises and acknowledge and understand that included within the scope of this waiver and release is any cause of action (including any cause of action based on negligence) arising from the performance, or failure to perform, maintenance, inspection, supervision or control of said areas and for the failure to warn of dangerous conditions existing at said rinks, for negligent selection of certain releasees, or negligent supervision or instruction by releasees.

Participant (and participant's parent(s)/guardian(s), if applicable) agree if any claim for participant's personal injury or wrongful death is commenced against releasees, he/she shall defend, indemnify and save harmless releasees from any and all claims or causes of action by whomever or wherever made or presented for participant's personal injuries, property damage or wrongful death.

Participant (and participant's parent(s)/guardian(s), if applicable) acknowledges that they have been provided and have read the above paragraphs and have not relied upon any representations of releasees, that they are fully advised of the potential dangers of ice hockey and understand that by signing these waivers and releases, have given up substantial rights. Furthermore, the undersigned agrees that if any portion of this waiver & release is held invalid, the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect. Significant exclusions may apply to Yeshiva Hockey's insurance policies, which could affect any coverage. For example, there is no liability coverage for claims of one player against another player. Furthermore, consent is given to have pictures taken of the participant and that such pictures will become the property of Yeshiva Hockey who may use them for promotional purposes without the payment of fees or other compensation.
